I recently purchased the Nutrafin Nutramatic 2X Automatic Feeder for my tanks, and I must say it's been a mixed bag of experiences. The only information provided on the box was to turn it on, but no instructions or guidance on how long it would run for or what size portions it would dispense. This led to some chaos in my tank, with fish swimming frantically around their enclosures as I tried to figure out what was going on. Despite the initial confusion, we eventually agreed that I would take it home and try to get it working myself. To be honest, I have no idea how it works or how to fix it if anything goes wrong. The picture shows it attached to the top of the tank, but I'm not sure if this is even possible. The feeder comes with a small drum that needs to be filled with Nutrafin flakes every 12 hours. According to the instructions (which there are none), this should rotate and dispense an unspecified amount of food down into the tank. Has anyone else had any experience with this product, or do you know where I can find more reliable alternatives? For my next holiday, which is just around the corner, I'll probably let the fish fast for a bit anyway. However, during the summer months when I'm away for two weeks, I want to make sure they're fed regularly. Unfortunately, my regular feeders are unreliable due to various health issues and travel constraints. One tip that might be helpful is to experiment with the "slider" that adjusts the amount of food dispensed. You can test this by simply rotating the entire unit to see how much comes out, rather than relying on batteries. I've had no problems with this feeder in the past, but now I usually err on the side of caution and let my fish fast for a bit. Another option is to use pre-measured amounts of food in a weekly pill box container and have a neighbor help me out. This way, I can keep things simple and avoid overfeeding, which tends to happen when helpers get involved.
