Before taking further steps, try restarting the unit as it may resolve any issues with the indicators or operation. If this doesn't work, follow these procedures to reset your unit's settings. Firstly, attempt to reset the settings by following these steps: - Press and hold while pressing M-DAX and ZONE2 SOURCE simultaneously. - Release the buttons once "Initialized" appears on the display. Alternatively, use the 'Save & Load' function from the menu to save your current settings before resetting them to their default values. You can also reset all network settings using the menu. If issues persist after trying these methods, consider restoring the firmware to its factory defaults. This will require you to press and hold while pressing M-DAX and TUNER PRESET CH + simultaneously. Wait for "Restore FW..." to appear on the display before releasing the buttons. The unit will automatically restart once the process is complete. If this operation doesn't improve the problem, contact our customer service center for further assistance. It's essential not to turn off the power until the firmware restore is complete. For AV and AVR models, there's a Factory Reset option available in the menu under General -> Factory Reset. This allows you to reset all saved settings or just network settings. We recommend saving your settings to a USB drive before factory resetting the unit. Another method for resetting the microprocessor involves following the push button reset procedure found in your model's owner's manual, as each model has its unique procedure.
