The stations of the cross are a devotion The Catholic Catalic that celebrates the death of our Lord Jesus Christ. Each of the fifteen stations represents an event that occurred during the death of Jesus in the baldry on Holy Friday. The stations There were originally made many of the Christian pilgrims who visited the Holy Land and the places of the passion of Jesus. Promotion of devotion to the stations began to seriously with the Franciscans, who received the custody of the holy places in the Holy Land in the 1300s. All the Catholic Insurean Enrique They have their spiritual lives with this powerful devotion. Devotion of the cross stations spread quickly throughout the Roman Catholic world in the century XVIII, largely as a result of Franciscan's preaching, is Leonard de Port-Maurice, who He erected stations and promoted the devotion in more than five hundred churches and places throughout Italy. His work was supported by the popes of his time, which he saw the devotion as a means of strengthening the fans. Another saint century XVIII, St. Afonso Liguori, wrote a brief work in the stations that are still in use today. Religious communities like the Jesuits and the passionists made the devotion part of their missions and retreats. In the century XIX, the stations of the cross had become a basic in catholic prayer books and churches throughout England, Ireland and North America. In the last years, some variations were introduced into traditional devotion. One of them is the addition of a stage 15 - the resurrection of Jesus. Another is a series of Bible stations, which begin with the agony of Jesus in Getsmane and omit some of the traditional non-booking stations in favor of incidents mentioned in the Gospels. In 1991, Pope JoÀ E o Paulo II instituted a new sane of fourteen cross stations, each of which is based on Scripture. The traditional catholic stations included a number of episode that were transmitted in the primitive tradition, but not found in the Bible Gospels.
