First conditional: if I have enough money, I go to Japan. 2. Second conditioned: If I had enough money, I would go to Japan. 3. Third condition: If I had enough money, I would have gone to Japan. Clausemain Conditional Claus 1. If + tense present will + inf / present tense / imperative if you help me with the dishes (if + pres). I will help you with your home lesson. (Will + Inf) If the sum of the dips of a number is divided by three, the number is divisible by three (tense presence) if you see Mr. Fox tonight, tell him that I am sick. (imperative). 2. SE + TENSE PASS + INF 3. SE + PERTY PERFECT PERFECT I HAD PAST + PARTICIPAL PAST, usually we do not use will or would in the conditional clause, only in the main clause. Uses of the first conditional conditional: open condition, what is said in the condition is possible. Time: This condition refers to presenting or for future time. for example. If he's late, we'll have to go without him. If my mother knows that, we are in a few days. Second Conditional: Unreal (impossible) or improbable situations. Present tense: The tense is past, but we are talking about the present, now. for example. If I knew her name, I'd say you. If I were you, I would tell my father. Compare: If I become president, I will change the social security system. (He said for a presidential candidate) if I became president, I would change the social security system. (Said for a student: Improvisable) If we win this game, we are qualified for semifinals. If I won a million pounds, I would stop teaching. (Improvisable) Third Conditional: Unreal time: past (then we are speaking of a situation that was not like this in the past.) E. If you warned me, I would not have Your father about this party. (But you do not, and I have). To remember! 1. Conditional construction usually does not use will or would do in clauses. Exception: If you want or express disposition, as in the requests, they can be used à €
