To sign up for Gmail, create a Google Account. You can use the username and password to sign in to Gmail and other Google products like YouTube, Google Play, and Google Drive. You can use Drive for desktop to keep your files in sync between the cloud and your computer. Syncing is the process of downloading files from the cloud and uploading files from your computer's hard drive. After syncing, the files on your computer match the files in the cloud. If you edit, delete, or move a file in one location, the same change happens in the other location. That way, your files are always up to date and can be accessed from any device. All of your Drive files appear here. Any new files or folders you create in Drive or Drive for desktop sync and appear on all your devices. Click Drive for desktop Open Drive folder . In My Drive or Shared drives, double-click the file that you want to open. Files created by Google Docs, Sheets, Slides, or Forms open in your browser. Other files open in their regular applications on your computer. Set up sync You can manage how much local storage you use and where your content is located by configuring Drive to stream or mirror your files and folders. Switch between recent apps Swipe up from the bottom, hold, then let go. If you're on Android Go with 3-button navigation, tap Recent apps . Swipe left or right to switch to the app you want to open. Tap the app that you want to open. Close apps Important: Some apps, like Google Play services or system apps, can't be stopped. Learn more about Google Play services. Close one app: Swipe up from the bottom, hold, then let go. Swipe up on the app. Close all apps: Swipe up from the bottom, hold, then let go. Swipe from left to right. On the left, tap Clear all. Close all apps on Android Go: Swipe up from the bottom, hold, and let go. At the bottom, tap Clear all. Find your Home screen: Tap Home or Home . Tip: Even if you don't close apps, you won't run out of memory or battery. Android manages these automatically. Get new apps You can get more apps in the Play Store app . Learn how to download apps.
