Enlarge the Beneluxa coalition, the most advanced of the European regional clusters (from now on the 'regional'), the reflection paper analyses multi-level cooperation, examines the progress made so far and seeks to predict the challenges and opportunities these alliances will face in Europe, a new culture of cooperation is being promoted between officials of the participating Member States, who share resources, create skills and exchange information and experiences. above all, they are learning to trust each other. The International horizon scanning initiative (hsi), a company derived from the Beneluxa, has created a new platform for exchange for public authorities. Its primary objective is to mitigate the effects of information asymmetries that compromise the influence of governments in negotiations with pharmaceutical companies. This rapid alarm system will provide public administrations with more and better information on what is planned for businesses. Together with a common determination and an early public announcement of willingness to pay, public authorities hope to be able to break the limit prices strategies of pharmaceutical companies.
