For instance, during NFT Paris 2024, Ethereum, the primary blockchain for NFTs, experienced a price increase of 3.5% to \$3,200, reflecting the market's positive response to the event. However, the NFT market has also faced challenges, including significant declines in trading volumes and valuations. Notably, platforms like OpenSea have seen monthly sales plummet from \$6 billion in January 2022 to under \$430 million by mid-2023, highlighting the market's volatility. Potential Outcomes for NFT Paris 2025 Given the scale and prominence of NFT Paris 2025, several potential market effects could happen: Renewed Interest: The event may rekindle enthusiasm in the NFT space, attracting new investors and creators, and potentially leading to a surge in NFT-related activities. Ticket Categories & Rights Attached to Tickets Categories NFT Paris may offer various ticket categories on the website, including special prices for startups or students, each subject to specific eligibility criteria clearly stated on the Event Website. Failure to do so may result in the loss of rights associated with the ticket and, in particular, access to the event, without eligibility for a refund.
