The Crewmates have the task of exploring the ship and completing the tasks to solve the problem, all avoiding the impostor(s), whose purpose is to kill the crew members during their stay under cover. If you're the impostor, staying smart is a must: crewmates have various opportunities to vote "sus" (or suspicious) players out of the ship, which could mean a game for the impostor (s) - or an incorrect ousting of legitimate crewmates. But, like all viral hits, between Us is not getting the same buzz that once did. After all, there are no ton of maps or game modes, so while playing online offers the most in terms of repetition value, even that emotion begins to fade after a few months. With this in mind, we have created a list of must-play social deduction games for those who feel that we are tired.
