You can easily set Google as your homepage each time you open your browser by making it your default homepage. Change your homepage settings by selecting your browser from the list and following the steps on your device. If your browser isn't listed, visit the "Help" section for instructions on adjusting homepage settings. For Firefox, open the browser and go to [www.google.com](http://www.google.com). Drag the tab to the Home button and release it. Confirm by clicking Yes. In Chrome, click More Settings in the top right corner. Under "Appearance," enable the Show home button option. Set your homepage to [www.google.com](http://www.google.com). For Safari, open Preferences, then General. Choose Homepage under "New windows open with" and "New tabs open with." Enter [www.google.com](http://www.google.com) as the homepage URL. Internet Explorer requires navigating to Tools > Internet Options > General tab. Input [www.google.com](http://www.google.com) under "Home page." Restart the browser to apply changes. Microsoft Edge users should select More Settings, then under "Set your homepage," choose a specific page. Replace the current homepage with [www.google.com](http://www.google.com). If Google remains stuck as your homepage, reset the settings and replace it with your preferred site. Check for malware if the issue persists. To make Google your default search engine, adjust browser settings. Chrome users can access Settings via the top right menu or <chrome://settings>. Under "Search engine," select Google. Edge users should go to Privacy, search, and services, then set Google as the default search provider. Internet Explorer 11 requires managing add-ons and setting Google Search as the default. For older versions, navigate to Tools > Internet Options > General tab and set Google as the default search engine. Firefox and Safari users can adjust search settings through their respective menus. Android browsers can set Google as the default search engine via Settings > Advanced > Search engine. Ensure the search widget is enabled for new devices. To post on Google in the European Economic Area (EEA) on or after March 1, 2020, follow these steps: Open the Google app on your Android device . Navigate to your Profile page, then tap the three horizontal lines at the top right corner, select Settings, and finally, tap Search widget Switch to Google.
