

The student may log on to student central. Please note that only students with confirmed enrollment will be allowed to generate COR. This means that minimum down payment is already settled or promissory note is already approved. Historical COR can also be generated by setting Academic Year and Academic Term, then click Print. If the student is currently enrolled, the student must present the original PSA Birth Certificate for verification. If the applicant is not enrolled or has already graduated in FEU, they must submit the original copy of PSA Birth Certificate, personal affidavit and joint affidavit of two disinterested parties to the Office of the University Registrar. Go to the FEU website (www.feu.edu.ph). Choose the tab named Academics Click on Apply for Student Records under Registrar Services or click this link: Academic Records Online Request Hub The amounts vary depending on the document requested. Corresponding fees are included in the Academic Records Online Request Hub. Once the request is verified, you will receive an e-mail with the corresponding fees or payment methods. How do you verify that the person applying online is indeed the FEU alumnus? The applicant just needs to complete the information required in the online application form. The information given will then be verified against the records at the OUR. The applicant must submit a clear photocopy of the original diploma to the OUR. For those students enrolled in 2001 and earlier, the OUR processes a certified true copy of the transcript of records since we only maintain a hardcopy of the original records in our files. The original copy is photocopied in security paper. In contrast, the transcript of records of our students whose enrollment starts in AY 2002-2003 onwards are automatically cleared and maintained in our computer system such that these are printed as original copied in security paper. Yes. Prepare a letter of request for verification of academic information, stating the complete name used while studying in college and full middle initial; Attachment of the photocopy/scanned copy of transcript of records or diploma that has been submitted in your office and; An authorization to release records signed from the FEU alumnus or former student and a copy of their valid ID should be emailed to registrar@feu.edu.ph. An alumnus or former student can apply from a remote province or from abroad. The courier charges vary depending on the place of destination. It depends. For an alumnus or former student who entered FEU in 2002 or later, it will take less time because the records are automatically printed if no accountabilities are registered in the computer system. The applicant may check the status of the application within 10 working days. Processing period is fifteen (15) working days. Far Eastern University started out as a dream, born virtually out of its founders head, Dr. Nicanor Reyes, in 1928 with the help of a reputed group of educators from the Department of Economics in University of the Philippines. The university practically began life as the Institute of Accountancy that initially offered a three-year program designed to meet the minimum requirements for the certified public accountant examination. In order to respond to the needs of the times, the Institute soon branched out to other fields of study. A year after, it became the Institute of Accounts, Business and Finance (IABF). In November 1933, FEU became a result of the fusion of Far Eastern College which offered courses in the liberal arts founded in 1919 and the IABF which offered courses in accountancy, economics, business administration, and banking and finance founded in 1929. Being the first president of the university, Dr. Reyes envisioned a school that would promote the teaching of accounting to Filipinos. The 30s and 40s became the building years of FEU. When the Pacific War broke out, the FEU campus became the headquarters of the Kempetai, right in the heart of Manila. Aside from burning and destroying the university records and facilities, the enemy forces also took the life of the great founder and some of his family members. Though bereft of its founding president, the university reopened in 1945 and ran by eminent educators as presidents-Dr. Hermenigildo Reyes, Jaime Hernandez, Dr. Francisco Dalupan, Clemente Uson, Dr. Leoncio Monson, Belem Enrile-Guiterrez, Dr. Vidal Tan, Dr. Teodoro Evangelista and the founders eldest son, Dr. Nicanor Reyes, Jr. After embarking on a massive expansion program of physical plant and facilities to accommodate its growing student population and to cope with the demands of modern, relevant education for a developing country during the post-liberation years, FEU also geared towards elevating the level of academic excellence by advanced instruction and professional training to qualified students by establishing the Institute of Graduate Studies. Various curricula were also reviewed which paved the way for new academic programs. According to former FEU president Lydia Echaz, DBA, the university is a premiere university in the country. It is a university of choice among high school graduates because FEU has had long and rich history in education, culture, arts and sports, she enthuses. In addition to academic excellence, the university strives to impart a well-rounded education by providing alternatives to students. And with the pronounced effort to upgrade the faculty, the research program, and the physical plant, the university climbs further towards quality education. For the past years since its founding, FEU has produced business tycoons, ambassadors, justices of Supreme Court and other judicial bodies, technocrats in private and government sectors, finance wizards, acclaimed physicians, nurses, educators, theater and media luminaries and so many others in different fields of expertise. Freshmen applicants are those who have completed middle school (senior high) making them eligible to apply for college education. However, for admission to the university, the applicants will need to undergo further screening and selection based on the criteria and policies. Qualifications: Satisfactory completion of middle school or its equivalent, e.g. Philippine Educational Placement Test (PEPT) or a Non-Formal Equivalency test both given and certified by the Department of Education Passing the FEU College Admissions Test (FEU-CAT). Application fees of applicants from Public Schools belonging to the TOP 10 of their Grade 11 batch may be waived upon submitting a certification from their school principal indicating their academic standing. Online Registration Steps Register via Check the link provided in your registered email to activate your account. Log-in using the provided username and temporary password. Then, update your password promptly. Click Sign-in, then select Application Form. Fill out all the necessary information, then click Submit once done. Pay the Php 500.00 FEUCAT fee. Select Application Fee to upload your proof of payment. Select Exam Booking then click on Launch Exam Booking Page for your preferred FEUCAT Schedule. Log-in to your account two weeks after your FEUCAT schedule to get your application results. For tourist visa holders, authorized stay must be valid up to 30 days upon submission for students visa conversion processing. Submit all visa requirements and school credentials at AFA for enrollment. ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP Awarded to 1st year exam takers who meet the eligibility requirements and will enroll during the 1st semester of the academic year. A grantee receives tuition and other fees of P 40,000/year, a book allowance of P 10,000/year, a monthly living allowance of P 7,000/month, and clothing allowance. CHED TES Tulung Dunong Program This is a financial assistance program offered by the Philippines Commission on Higher Education (CHED). It aims to help financially challenged students in pursuing higher education by providing tuition, school fees, and a monthly allowance. Every CHED SUC Tulung Dunong Scholar will receive a scholarship grant of Php7,500.00 (Seven thousand five hundred pesos) for the Fiscal Year. CHED Tertiary Education System This is a grant-in-aid program under RA 10931 OR Universal Access to Tertiary Education Act given to qualified students enrolled in CHED-recognized public and private higher education institutions to support at least the partial cost of tertiary education. It provides up to Php 20,000 per school year for tuition and other school fees. It also provides up to Php 40,000 per school year for education-related expenses, including rental or purchase of computer, books and supplies, transportation, and lodging and board expenses. Philippine Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO) This grant is available for a veteran of the Philippine Army or of any recognized or deserving guerrilla organization who took active participation in the resistance movement and/or in the liberation drive against the enemy during World War II, or of the Philippine Expeditionary Forces to Korea, or of the Philippine Civic Action Group or Philippine Contingent in Vietnam, who has never heretofore enjoyed educational benefit under Philippine law nor under United States law, who desires to study; or one (1) child of a veteran in whose favor he renounces such right; or the surviving spouse or a child of a deceased veteran in whose favor the same is applied for by the surviving spouse, or legal guardian; shall, upon certification of the Administrator, be admitted to any school, college, university or institution authorized by the Government, with all school fees, including tuition, matriculation, athletic, library, laboratory, medical, military training, diploma and graduation fees, at the expense of the Government, subject to the rules and conditions promulgated by the Administrator.
