## Motorcycle safety academy baltimore

Motorcycle Safety Academy is located at 1201 S Caton Ave, Baltimore, MD 21227. It has received an average rating of 5 stars from 89 reviews. The academy offers training courses and is known for its customer satisfaction, quality service, and kind support. It is a one-stop destination for motorcycle safety needs. Motorcycle Safety Academy is functional on Sundays and can be found using Google Maps. A nearby landmark is the MD 21227 sign. The academy has been approved as a motorcycle safety training provider for the Pennsylvania Motorcycle Safety Program (PAMSP). A new on-road motorcycle safety course is in development and will be announced soon. The business recently launched a new website design and opened a training center in Essex, MD. Our instructors are highly experienced and certified professionals with a strong background in motorcycle riding, industry expertise, and instruction. They actively participate in continuing education to stay up-to-date on the latest techniques, safety standards, and industry trends. Our mission is to help each student reach their full potential when learning to ride. We offer courses approved by the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration and the Motorcycle Safety Foundation, catering to both new and experienced riders. The Motorcycle Safety Academy in Halethorpe, MD, provides motorcycle training courses for both new and experienced riders. Their courses, developed by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF), focus on safety and road skills, with instructors having extensive backgrounds in the motorcycle industry. The academy's license-earning courses are approved by the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) and include comprehensive training sessions. Riders completing the course receive a Maryland Motorcycle Safety Course Completion Card. Those with a Maryland Driver's License are eligible for the M-endorsement. However, passing or becoming license/endorsement eligible is not guaranteed for course participants. When attending our courses: Each class is taught only in English and translators aren't allowed. Students must arrive on time; those arriving late won't be permitted to participate due to MVA and MSF guidelines. Students are responsible for their own riding gear, which the instructor will inspect. If any item doesn't meet standards, participation will be denied. Montgomery College provides no gear for borrowing. Approved attire includes: a sturdy jacket/shirt, long pants without tears/holes, over-the-ankle footwear with low heels, full-fingered gloves, and a DOT-compliant helmet or ¾-style helmet with eye protection. The helmet should meet FMVSS 218 standards, be in good condition, and have intact labeling. If it's more than five years old, it shouldn't be used. Students without proper gear won't participate or receive a refund/ rescheduling. Our Motorcycle Basic Rider Course is an approximately 18-hour MVA-certified course for those with little/no riding experience. It includes distance learning (MSF 5-hour eCourse) and online classroom sessions. The Basic Rider Course 2 - License Waiver (BRC2-LW) is an 11-hour program designed for individuals with current street riding experience seeking the M-endorsement. It includes distance learning, online classroom instruction, and riding skills training. Motorcycles are provided, but students can also use their own bike if they transport it legally to the range. To participate, you must have existing street riding experience and wear appropriate safety gear. Upon completing the course requirements, including knowledge and riding skills tests, students will be eligible for the M-endorsement and receive a recognized course completion card from the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA). Note that passing this course does not automatically grant you legal motorcycle riding status; you must still add the endorsement at the MVA to become a licensed rider. A separate Basic Skills Enhancement Course is available, a five-hour on-cycle program focusing on basic riding exercises. This course is designed for riders who have previously taken or been part of a BRC and want to practice and improve their fundamental skills. Motorcycles are available for use during this course, along with helmets. Please note that this is not a licensing course and no license waiver or completion card will be issued. **\*\*Advanced Skill Course\*\*** This half-day on-cycle program focuses solely on riding exercises without any testing. It's designed for riders who already have a motorcycle license and own an insured vehicle. The class uses personal motorcycles and doesn't involve formal classroom instruction. **\*\*Required Documents\*\*** Upon registration, students must provide a valid motorcycle license and proof of insurance to participate in the course. The Motorcycle Safety Foundation's (MSF) learner-centric training model focuses on how individuals learn complex skills, particularly motor skill development principles. The MSF curriculum is structured to accommodate riders with varying levels of experience, from beginners to those with intermediate skills. The program emphasizes a three-stage development process: cognitive, associative, and automated. This approach allows learners to progress from simple to complex activities while receiving feedback from instructors and peers. The MSF Basic e-Course provides online learning for the general public and MSF course participants, mirroring the content of the BRC Rider Handbook. The Street Strategies eCourse is designed for riders with basic skills, building on the knowledge gained from the Basic e-Course. The Motorcycle Safety Academy offers various courses, including the Basic Rider Course (BRC), Advanced Course, and 3-Wheel Basic Rider Course. Successful completion of an MDMSP Basic or Advanced Course waives the requirement to take a written and skills test at the Maryland MVA Driver License Center, earning the student a Completion Certificate. This certificate can be taken to any full-service MVA to get the "M" placed on a license.
