To maintain control over caps lock, users can take several steps. To re-enable the Caps Lock key, you can restore the Registry backup or edit the Registry to enable it again. To disable Caps Lock key on your Mac, follow these steps: Open a pop-up window and click No Action from the drop-down menu. If you have a Touch Bar, instead click Escape here. Then, click OK at the bottom of the window to save your changes. Note that if you still can't activate Caps Lock after doing this, restart your Mac by clicking Apple menu, then Restart...
