Investiture Ceremony For Filipino Scouts Ang dokumento na ito ay naglalaman ng seremonya ng pagtanggap ng mga kandidato bilang bagong kasapi ng Girl Scout sa Pilipinas. Ang mga kandidato ay tinatawagan upang sumali sa pagtatalaga. Pagkatapos, ang mga Scout ay naglabas at nagpasya na maglinggo sa isang ganap na scout. ##### Panalangit Ang mga Scout ay pinagsimulaan ng panalangin upang magising at magmarami ng bahagi sa Diyos. Ang kulay ay isang simbolo ng pagtatalaga at pagkakaisa. ##### Pambansang Awit Ang pambansang awit ng Pilipinas ang umagisag sa diwa ng scouting, samantalang ang mga Scout ay nagmarami ng bahagi sa kultura at katutubong Pilipino. ##### Panunumpa Ng Scout Sa panahon ng seremonya, ang mga kandidato ay nagkasagawa ng panunumpa upang magising bilang isang ganap na scout. Ang pinakatagalagang bagay sa buhay ng isang scout ay ang paggawa ng buong makakaya. Ang pagtatalaga sa scouting ay isang personal na pagsubok. Amen. Please remain standing as we honor our national pride with the Philippine National Anthem. (Play the national anthem) As a symbol of unity and loyalty, we take our stand for the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, led by Mdmn. Lawrence Añonuevo. (Recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance) It is my pleasure to welcome Dr. Milagros S. Esparrago, Principal of Senior High School Department, to deliver the Opening & Welcome Remarks. To our esteemed guests, Scout Officials, Council Scout Executive, beloved Scouts, Parents and Guardians, distinguished guests, let us extend a warm Good Morning! I am honored to welcome you all and officially open this year's Investiture Ceremony at Mariners Polytechnic Colleges Foundation of Legazpi City (Albay) Inc. Scouting has been an integral partner in shaping our students' character, promoting values such as peace, skills, and self-reliance. We embark on this journey with high hopes, embracing new members and fostering a culture of citizenship, character building, and leadership development. Please join me in welcoming Dr. Esparrago for these inspiring words. Thank you, Dr. Esparrago, for your warm welcome. We now proceed to the Investiture Ceremony Proper, where we will formally invest our Scout Officials, Council Scout Executive, and Troop Leaders. Let us extend a warm welcome to these distinguished guests! The next part of the program is the most anticipated event - The Investiture Ceremonies Proper. May BSP Representative facilitate this meaningful ceremony. Senior Crew Leader brings the candidates forward. (SCL commands the candidates and bring it at the front of the ceremonial stage.) Sir, I present to you [No.of Candidates] who desires to be admitted to the Outfit of Senior Scout Sisterhood and Brotherhood and receive initiation in your hands. Are they worthy? SCL: They are worth, for they know their weaknesses and trust not in their own strength but seek help from Almighty God and the fellowship of their brother and sister scouts. Candidates: I do (Execute Scout Sign and recite in unison) Do you understand that by becoming a Senior Scout, you join a Brotherhood/Sisterhood, where we ask you to obey our rules and carry out our motto of humble service for others? Candidates: I do (Execute Scout Sign and recite in unison) In ancient times, it was customary to be laved with water as a symbol of washing away past misdeeds. Are you willing to give such a sign here in the presence of all? Candidates: I am (The SCL will present a basin of water, and candidates dip their fingers together and wipe them with the napkin) And now, Ladies and Gentlemen, let us proceed to the Candle Lighting Ceremony. (The lights will be dimmed, and the herald mace will be lit.) BSP Rep: Candidates, listen as the Scout Badge speaks. (The voice of the Scout Badge is heard) Voice of the Scout Badge: I represent the ideals of scouting. Scouts, know me and wear me proudly in your uniform. (The trefoil symbol is revealed, representing the true direction scouts should follow.) Voice of the Scout Badge: This symbolizes faith, truth, and knowledge, the foundations of scout citizenship. It also signifies bravery, purity, and high political ideals. (The three mullet stars in gold symbolize the ideals of faith, truth, and knowledge.) Voice of the Scout Badge: These eight rayed sun represents liberty, hope, and light, serving as a reminder that service to our country is part of scouting. (The scroll with the scout motto is unrolled.) A smiling scout's mouth is a symbol reminding us all to be generous with our smile, wherever we are. Wear it proudly on your uniform as you go out into the world, showcasing scouts' readiness for service to God, country, people, and yourselves. Scout A: Duty to God and Country is brought to life by bringing life to scouting's ideals. Fulfill obligations to creator and motherland. During this ceremony, lighting the first candle symbolizes duty to God and Country. All present makes the sign of the cross and murmurs "God is great; God is kind, and God is Merciful." Scout B: Bringing life to next greatest ideals means Duty to others and Duty to self. Light second and third candles, respectively. Fulfill best in helping others while keeping physically strong, mentally awake, and morally straight. BSP Rep: As you stare at the three lighted candles, remember wonderful adventures ahead in scouting. I now call selected scouts to project twelve points of scout law. Scout No.1: A Scout is Trustworthy by honour being trusted. Violation leads to losing trust and handing over badge. Scout No.2: Loyalty is due-to leaders, home, parents, and country for a loyal scout. Scout No.3: Helping others without expecting reward is the spirit of helping. Scout No.4: Being friendly to all people, young and old alike, shows a friendly scout. Scout No.5: A courteous scout polites to everyone, especially women, children, and old people. Scout No.6: Kindness towards animals and plants, while not hurting needlessly. Scout No.7: Obedience is prompt and cheery, obeying parents, leaders, and authorities. Scout No.8: Being cheerful never shrks or grumbles at hardships. Scout No.9: A thrifty scout does not destroy property but works faithfully. Scout No.10: Bravery means facing danger despite fear for a brave scout. Scout No.11: Keeping the body and thoughts clean is the spirit of a clean scout. Scout No.12: Being reverent towards God, faithful in religious duties, and respecting others' customs. BSP Rep: You have come seeking admission to scouting, an international movement with ancient scope taking place of knighthood. You passed tests and took oath, now before you take the oath again, is anything unclear? All Scouts in unison: None sir, candle. It represents the Spirit of Scouting. The Scout Ideals, found in the Scout Oath and Law, offer a guide for living and a standard for behavior that all members of the Scouting Movement must follow at all times. Scout spirit is living daily by these ideals, shown through actions and words in Scouting and everyday life. As you grow as Scouts, you'll learn more about this spirit. The law of the Outfit is the Scout Law, known and followed by millions. You'll learn and follow it too. The Senior Crew Leader will now lead the rededication of the Scout Oath & Law. (The named scout steps up and commands "Attention") (All Senior Scouts stand at attention) (The scout commands "Scout Sign" and all follow.) (The scout says: "The Scout Oath and Law, follow after me") On my Honor, I will do my best, to do my duty to God and my Country, The Republic of the Philippines; and to obey the scout law; to help other people at all times; to keep myself physically strong, mentally awake and morally straight. The Scout is Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Friendly, Courteous, Kind, Obedient, Cheerful, Thrifty, Brave, Clean, and Reverent. Outfit Advisor: "Very well. We began in near darkness. Now, with these candles lit, we can see clearly and renew our commitment to the Scout Oath & Law. Senior Crew Leader: Very well, I join you in this mission. I'll now call our Outfit Scribe for the Scout Motto commitment. Outfit Scribe: The Scout Motto, "Laging Handa" or "Be Prepared," reminds Scouts of their purpose and training. It prepares them for responsible citizenship and leadership. Through Scouting, they gain skills to serve others. Scouting is about readiness to help, hence the motto "Laging Handa." Do you accept this motto? Participants: "I do." Outfit Scribe: I'm pleased with your pledge. Now, I'll call our Outfit Quartermaster for the Senior Scout Slogan. Outfit Quarterm. The Senior Scout Slogan is "Once a Scout always a Scout." It's a reminder that even after leaving Scouting, we remain Scouts in spirit. Do you agree? Participants: "We do!" Outfit Quartermaster: Well said. I stand with you. I'll now call our Outfit Treasurer for the Scout Salute and Sign. Outfit Treasurer: My fellow Scouts, before us are the Philippine Flag and the BSP Flag. Let us show respect with the Scout Sign. The Scout Sign is made with the right hand, palm forward, fingers pointing up, thumb folded over the little finger. The arm forms a right angle, symbolizing the Scout trefoil's three parts. These fingers show reaching for higher ideals. The thumb and little finger symbolize unity and brotherhood worldwide. The Scout Sign is used during the Oath, Law, and Panunumpa sa Watawat. It's also a greeting among Scouts. Ready front! Fellow Scouts, Scout Salute! The salute is made with the right hand in the Scout Sign, touching the eyebrow. If in uniform, the salute honors the flag and anthem. It's a sign of respect and unity. ###Looking forward to seeing everyone at the meeting tomorrow where we will be presenting the Senior Scout Medallion. SENIOR SCOUT MEDALLION / EMBLEM It represents everything that Senior Scouting stands for. The red double S letter in gold symbolizes our outdoor adventures as a winding road leading to the horizon. The golden field upon which the double letter S is laid represents those valuable qualities we strive to possess. The trefoil reminds us that, as Senior Scouts, we are part of a worldwide brotherhood committed to selfless service. The double S also represents our three main programs: Land, Sea, and Air Scouting. It symbolizes the pathways taken by Land Scouts through the woods. So too does it symbolize the red sails flapping in the wind as Sea Scouts embark on an adventure along the coast. The double S is represented in red for the courageous spirit we must exemplify on our journey to a better life. I now call our Outfit Advisor to present the Scout Neckerchief and Wooden Carabao Slide before our acceptance ceremony. BSP Rep: Fellow Scouts, before you is the Scout Neckerchief and Carabao Slide, which I will explain its symbolism. Our Neckerchief represents our identity and uniform, serving many practical purposes such as a bandage or tourniquet during emergencies. It also protects our head from the sun's heat. The Wooden Carabao Head as Slide symbolizes hard work, humility, perseverance, and strength. It is an animal of burden that is valuable to Filipino farmers. We will now proceed with the investing ceremony of Girl Scout candidates. May we call on Ms. April M. Madridano to lead the girls in candle lighting? Master of Ceremonies: We are now proceeding to the investing ceremony of the Girl Scout candidates. Please light your candles, and when you do, repeat one part of the promise. Leader: What was the promise you made as a Girl Scout? Girls: We tried to be trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friends to all, courteous, respectful of living things, disciplined, self-reliant, thrifty, clean in thought, word, and deed. Now is the time for us to leave the horseshoe and travel to wider lands. Growing up is not easy, but may your eyes be opened to those around you. May your understanding and compassion be greater because of what you see. Go now, look wider, and good luck. Before we proceed, I would like to ask, WHO ARE YOU, AND WHERE DO YOU WISH TO GO? We are cadet girls who wish to take our Promise into a wide world. We will now assist the parents and guardians in pinning their sons' neckerchiefs as a symbol of acceptance. The VPA: By my authority, I declare you as full-fledged members of Boy Scout and Girl Scout of the Philippines. You may accept your Membership IDs from your Scout Officials in the presence of loved ones. We will now complete our membership by presenting the Institutional Charter. Council Scout Executive: Before I formally present this Charter, I would like to express my gratitude to the Outfit Advisor, parents, and guardians for giving you this opportunity to join our noble movement. To all Scouts and esteemed guests, let me read the content of this Institutional Charter certifying your full pledge membership, as presented by the Council Scout Executive. Congratulations to everyone! Now it's time for us to reaffirm the values that we commit to fulfill. And now let us hear the message of our Dear President/VPA. Having been a witness with this kind of ceremony is indeed an inspiration in itself, while being courageous in doing good and avoiding wrongs. Our Lord, make us CLEAN; help us to have a pure heart so that we can see God. Make us REVERENT; teach us to love You with all our hearts, minds, and strength. Our Scouting journey began with You, let it end with You, the Great Scoutmaster of all. We pray in Your most holy name: AMEN. o. Is this your desire? The Scouts reply in unison, "Yes, Sir!" Sir Raf continues, "In this ceremony, you will be appointed as a member of scouting at Sto. Rosario Elementary School, following the principles of scouting worldwide." A symbolic candle is presented to them, representing the spirit of scouting. MA'AM ANNE: During this ceremony, you will learn many things about the scouting movement. The Scout Law and Charter are led by \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. PART III: PAGSISINDI NG KANDILA MA'AM ANNE: Now we proceed with the candle lighting ceremony. The main mission of scouting is to instill a scout's character so that they can be a good citizen of our country and have good manners. We will also cultivate good behavior in every Filipino child. The three candles represent the three principles of scouting: service to God, service to country, and self-service. SIR RAF: The three candles are lit now, symbolizing the three principles of scouting that must be followed by all scouts. If we do not follow the Scout Law, we will fail. MA'AM ANNE: Now, let us light 12 more candles representing the 12 points of the Scout Law.
