However, it might be a better idea to set your blog on your domain. Why? Well, for larger companies - which almost certainly do not use WordPress - the idea of installing additional online software will create security flags. After all, any vulnerability in the blog platform, theme, or plugin, could open the entire website and hacking servers. Not what anyone wants. So, what are you supposed to do? In such cases it is worth using a domain registrar to purchase a relative domain name – or even use an older domain that your company might use. For example, if your business address is .com, you may also have .org and .net to protect your brand.consider using one of these. Alternatively, simply opt for [BusinessName]blog.com or similar. Of course, you also want to use a different web hosting service to host your blog. Not only does it ensure that there is no security risk in handling it, it also means that if business website does actually go down you can use your blog to keep your customers up to date. If you write about other people, you are opening your reader, so talk about how passionate your employees are and make sure to mention their names. Talk about other people in business you admire, and talk about your customers, and also talk about your competitors and other people and businesses that you admire or hate – even if you pay attention to what you say, and not just make the blog a list. Most big companies look for their names and products online, and writing about them you will get on their radar. Join the Blogging CommunityNo blog is an island. Now that you have a blog, you're part of the blogger community, and reciprocity plays an important part of that. Some things you can do to connect with other bloggers (and probably get reciprocal traffic):Link generously. Not only is it a good way to cite your sources, but the links in your posts make your posts more search engine friendly.Leave comments and trackback on other blogs. Leaving a trackback puts a comment on the other blog noting that you are connected to that post. It has a dual effect of virtually tapping the blogger links on the shoulder and also putting your blog link in front of more readers.Update your blogroll. The list of "blogs you like" in the blogroll helps other bloggers to notice you. (And if you get listed on other blogs, more readers notice yours.) Try to turn casual readers into loyal ones as well. Engage with your blog commentators, create an email newsletter and encourage feedback.Invite others to post or even ask readers to contribute to your blog. You can double your promotional power this way.See if you can guest post or contribute to other, larger blogs. This is another great way to get noticed. In fact, many bloggers have done just that here at Lifehacker. You can start contributing to Lifehacker in a number of ways: from starting your own Kinja blog, to becoming an author on Hackerspace, or email submissions@lifehacker.com with your original posts for consideration.Even if you only give a larger site permission to republish content, it can be a huge benefit for you.
