The academy focuses on helping students become self-motivated learners by emphasizing academic excellence, developing critical thinking skills, and tailoring instruction to individual needs. They believe that everyone learns differently, so they offer personalized learning experiences through various methods like technology, classrooms, labs, electives, and independent study options. This flexibility allows students to complete their assigned program in a way that suits them best. Some of the partner universities include AMDA College of the Performing Arts and several other well-known institutions across the US. The Classical Academy Vista provides flexible educational learning plans, with different tracks for students in grades K-5 and 6-8. For instance, Track A/B involves two days on campus per week for grades K-5, while Track M includes three days on campus for grades 6-8. Students also participate in workshop classes with a maximum of 20 or 25 students per teacher, focusing on concept-based lessons in math, language arts, and science. Additionally, traditional recess and lunch breaks are incorporated into the day, and students complete assignments at home in language arts, math, and history. At Classical Academy Vista, students have access to electives like art, music, and technology during their time on campus. For Tracks A/B or M, students work independently with an adult supervisor on non-workshop days using the TCA curriculum. In contrast, Track C (Grades TK-8) offers more flexibility in curriculum selection, allowing students to work at home five days a week under the guidance of a credentialed teacher or Educational Specialist (ES). Regular communication with the ES via email, phone, or in-person meetings is required. Students in Transitional Kindergarten are assigned to Track C and receive support from a credentialed teacher and their parent or guardian as they prepare for kindergarten. Additionally, literacy and math specialists are available five days a week to support families and teachers. For the 2024-25 school year, re-enrollment for current families will begin on January 2, 2024, while open enrollment begins on March 4, 2024. Important dates include November 27, 2023 (lottery opens), February 9, 2024 (deadline for lottery entries), and February 15, 2025 (public lottery). New students must meet specific age requirements: Kindergarten students must turn five by September 1, 2024, while Transitional Kindergarten students must turn four between September 2nd - September 1st. First-time public school students require an Oral Health Assessment for kindergarten and a School Entry Health Check for first grade. Please note that all new students must meet these requirements, and enrollment can be completed entirely online.
