Although they've become an important part of the series' identity, Social Links weren't first introduced until Persona 3. In P3, Social Links were a means of creating a more immersive world while bolstering Persona 3's themes of individuality. While it can be argued that Persona 3 is a better game than its predecessors (in large part due to the respect & maturity of its subject matter) Persona 4 undeniably one-ups it when it comes to Social Links. More light-hearted than the average Persona title, P4 is a big change of pace for the series, but an incredibly memorable one with quite a memorable cast at the center of it all. Unlike in Persona 3, every party member has a Social Link in Persona 4 — but that doesn't mean they aren't outshined by Inaba's many NPCs. Today, we're ranking the best social links in the game. Updated on March 18, 2022 by Ritwik Mitra: Persona 4 is one of the most charming and enjoyable games in the series, even though its dark themes do end up taking center-stage at times. The game is full to the brim with amazing combat, a great small-town setting, and some of the most memorable characters in gaming history. In fact, Persona 4's characters and their Social Links are so memorable that most people would have varying favorites due to how brilliantly each and every one of them is written. The best ones of the bunch are mentioned below, based on how their personality shines during these Social Links. 15 Magician (Yusuke Hanamura) Yusuke fulfills the trope of being the happy-go-lucky best friend of the protagonist who is also pretty goofy in his own right. He seems pretty shallow at first glance... but Yusuke's Social Link is actually pretty deep and engaging. He ends up developing an inferiority complex while hanging out with Narukami, which is understandable given the amazing powers the protagonist has. Thankfully, he gets over this pretty quickly and starts to always be by Narukami's side, not matter what. This makes him the best party members in Persona 4 and the fan-favorite romance for many. She's always chirpy and active at all times, and the dynamic she shares with Yosuke is pretty hilarious as well. If he plays decision to build up a Social Link with her by working out frequently, they'll reveal a deeper to this character. She hates anyone who picks on the weak and goes out of her way to protect people, which is an extremely endearing character trait. Rise Kujikawa is another brilliant character who can become the protagonist's love interest. Given her status as an idol, it's understandable to assume that she might be pretty self-obsessed. However, it turns out that Rise is actually a pretty down-to-earth girl who just likes having fun, regardless of her celebrity status. All things considered, she's a generally great person and pleasant to get to know in Persona 4. Yukiko's Shadow being a bird in a cage summarizes her character perfectly. She's faced so much pressure in life that the very thought of not being perfect burdens her greatly. Thankfully, her time with Narukami and the Investigation Team allow her to express her true self and not be under so much pressure. It's an angle explored in her Social Link as well, making her a pretty memorable character indeed. It's hard to imagine that someone in a Teddie costume would be such a memorable character. However, it's Teddie's innocent and charming nature that makes him such a great character in his own right. There are times when this character might become a tad too annoying, but that doesn't take away from his endearing nature. The fact that his Social Link progresses automatically means that players are under no pressure to juggle another Social Link along with the ones they have to build up anyway. Not a part of the traditional tarot deck, the Jester Arcana was added into Persona 4 Golden as a means of giving Tohru Adachi some more depth. The Jester is the Fool's foil, and much of Adachi's Social Link is spent contrasting him with most Social Links. Where Yu is usually able to bring out the best in others, Adachi ends up being a fairly toxic friendship. It should be pointed out that Adachi's Social Link is optional until Rank 6, where it then weaves itself in as part of the story. For anyone looking to get the most out of Persona 4 Golden's story, Adachi's Jester Social Link is downright essential. All things considered, Persona 4 does not handle Kanji's introduction into the story well. The topic of his sexuality simply isn't treated with the respect it merits, at least not initially. Persona 4 finds its voice by the time Naoto joins the party, but Kanji's Social Link notably does a better job at dissecting his character in a far more nuanced manner. Kanji's Social Link focuses on the image of masculinity his father left for him while also reconciling his dungeoneer. Without a farcical caricature looking right at the player, Kanji coming to terms with what being a man means for him has much more weight in his Social Link. Plus, him making dolls is sweet. Although Persona 4 has better Social Links, it doesn't necessarily have better development for the main cast. Take Kanji, for instance. Without playing his S. Link, his arc rings rather hollow. The same is true for Yu's uncle, Ryoutra Dojima, who serves as the player's father figure while playing an incredibly important role in the main plot. Dojima's Social Link isn't important to that, but it reconciles his regrets over the death of his wife. Likewise, the Social Link allows Yu and Dojima to bond far more than they do in the main plot, which naturally gives their tense moments all the more meaning. Nanako's Social Link is arguably more important than Dojima's considering she's a more present character, but they both tie into each other. Where Dojima's Social Link focuses on his feelings towards his wife's death (8 the case it was linked to) Nanako's showcases the loneliness enforced on her by Dojima's obsession. Nanako's Social Link has her coming to terms with the fact that her dad does love her, while also vocalizing the mistreatment she's been subjected to. As Nanako and Dojima become key to the plot, completing this Social Link is a rather crucial step in ensuring Persona 4's last act lands with the emotional impact it needs. Unlike Kanji's Social Link which saw fit to remedy a part of his arc that wasn't handled particularly well in the main story, Naoto's Social Link chooses to instead flesh out an interesting aspect of her backstory the game naturally wouldn't be able to — her life in a family of detectives. Yu and Naoto team up during her Social Link to solve a makeshift mystery orchestrated by her grandfather. While the premise is fun, it's used to examine what being a detective means for Naoto. Her Social Link briefly touches upon her gender identity, but it's Naoto's passion for investigation that ultimately drives the Social Link, not Yu. Social Stats are a mechanic in Persona 4 Golden that open more in-game responses and Social Links once they've reached specific levels. These are broken up into five different levels that will accumulate points based on the protagonist's reactions or what he chooses to do in his free time. These stats include Kindness, Understanding, Expression, Knowledge, and Courage. Courage, as its name indicates, allows players to be more forward when the protagonist is interacting with other characters. If his Courage isn't high enough, he won't be able to speak class (Moon Arcana) or give responses that might give him more points towards a Social Link. In Persona 4 Golden, Courage has fewer methods of leveling up compared to the other Social Stats, but it's not impossible to max out on a first playthrough. Different Ways to Increase Courage Courage's five levels are: Average Reliable Brave Daring Heroic To Fully max out Courage, players will need to accumulate 140 or more Courage points. Some early-game responses allow players to gain one or two points towards Courage, but getting it to the next level will soak up some of the protagonist's free time. Books and Jobs The best ways of getting Courage points are by reading certain books and working at the hospital. Make sure to check the bookstore by the gas station in the Shopping District. The books that will influence the protagonist's Courage are: The Lonely Man Forever Macho \*100 Ghost Stories \*100 Ghost Stories" will double the amount of Courage gained from the hospital job. Reading will take up the protagonist's afternoon or evening time. The best time to read is in between dungeons or on days when there aren't as many Social Links available. Classmates (such as Yosuke, Yumi/Ayane, and Naoki) won't want to spend time with the protagonist on specific days of the week, or when exams are coming up. Take advantage of this time to read Courage-raising books. On May 25th, a hospital job will appear on the Bulletin Board by Ayaka's (Chinese Diner) in the Northern Shopping District. Applying for this job is how players can start the Devil Social Link (Uehara), but simply working there will add a point towards Courage. Unfortunately, the hospital job is only accessible in the evening/night on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. Other Methods of Increasing Courage Once Yosuke pesters the protagonist about getting "motorcycles," players will be able to ride a scooter outside Inaba starting June 9th. Taking the time to explore the area will give a point towards Courage. It's also necessary to ride the scooter out to the beach to complete the Hermit Social Link. Keep in mind that once Okina Station and the beach are unlocked, riding the scooter to these areas won't award any more Courage points. Return to a dungeon once it's been cleared and there will be a powerful Shadow in the boss room. These optional bosses are much tougher, so it's not recommended to challenge them until later in the game. However, defeating them is another way to gain Courage. Finally, eating at Aiya's will give five points towards Courage depending on the type of beef bowl they're serving up for that day. Visit Aiya's on April 19th to get five Courage points. Players can also eat some of the food that's left in the fridge at home. For example, players will gain an increase in Courage for eating the food on May 2nd. Not all refrigerated food will give Courage. Keep in mind that eating "bad food" rewards Courage, but it will waste evening/night free time. The earliest day players can eat rotten food from the fridge is on April 25th. Be sure to check the fridge from April to October. As most players have probably noticed, answering questions correctly will give points towards Social Links. There are also some answers that are blocked off if the protagonist's Social Stat isn't at a certain level. One Social Link in Persona 4 Golden is completely locked until the protagonist has enough Courage. Players will need Level 3 (Brave) Courage to start the Moon Arcana/Al Ebihara's Social Link. Ebihara will make an appearance during Rank 4 of the Strength Arcana (Kou or Daisuke). Ebihara will be in Classroom Building 1F on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday afternoons, so speak to her after reaching Rank 4 of the Strength Arcana and once Courage is at the proper level. It's not necessary to max out all Social Links in one playthrough to beat the game, but completing the Moon Arcana will unlock the fusion for Sandalphon, an Ultimate Persona. Be warned that it's very easy to Reverse the Moon Arcana if players give the wrong response to Ebihara. This will put the Social Link "on hold," and players will need to make up with Ebihara before they can hang out with her again. Avoid reversing Social Links to save on time. As mentioned earlier, having enough Courage will allow players to answer with the more "daring" responses. This includes standing up to other characters who may be harassing one of the protagonist's Social Links. Doing so might give points towards one of the other five Social Stats, thus making it easier to max them out as well. Persona 4 Golden is available now on PSP and Steam.
