The disease of the hand, foot and mouth is usually mild and does not cause an abundance of symptoms. Sometimes, pain, blisters or a red rash is the only symptom that the child will experience. They can appear on the hands, feet, buttocks and into his mouth, according to the Mayo Clinic. Your child can even run a fever, have a throat or lose your appetite. In newborns and younger children, irritability and general malaise can be seen, reports both the Mayo Clinic and the CDC. While the disease almost always occurs in children under five years of age, Children, adolescents and adults can also get it. Some researchers believe that younger children take it because they have not yet built immunity to the virus that causes it, reports the American Academy of Dermatology. Different viruses cause the disease and spread through contact with body fluids such as faeces, urine, respiratory drops, saliva and bladder fluid, according to the Mayo Clinic. The disease tends to occur more frequently during the warmer seasons of the year in the United States, and is more common in children attending kindergarten. Doctors typically diagnose the disease by performing a simple physical examination of blisters and other symptoms and comparing them with the age of the child, reports the CDC. They may also take a throat culture or a fecal sample and require a lab test for analysis. There is no treatment for the hand, foot and mouth, and typically goes on its own after 10 days, according to the American Academy of Dermatology. Doctors can treat symptoms, such as pain and fever, with prescribed medications and lifestyle changes, even the organization reports. During the very rare occasion, complications may arise from the disease. Some children may become dehydrated because blisters and sore throats prevent them from eating and drinking. Temporary loss of nails and nails may also occur. Other rare but potential complications are viral meningitis and encephalitis, which can lead to paralysis similar to that found in polio patients, reports the CDC.
